- artefacts and exhibit items which have (in the last two years) been part of your collections and which have had their authenticity questioned, i.e. they are suspected of being fakes/forgeries/counterfeit
- artefacts and exhibit items which have (in the last two years) been part your collections and have been confirmed as being inauthentic, i.e. they are confirmed as being fakes/forgeries/counterfiet
- the display history of these artefacts and exhibit items, i.e. when they were on display to the public
- information on internal decisions made regarding these issues

I would like full copies of relevant documents for the past two available (most recent) years. Confirmed as 1 January 2013 – 31 December 2014.





## Response

I have reviewed the Museum's information holdings and I have not found any information relating to your request, therefore, I am unable to provide you with the information you require. That being the case, I would inform you, in accordance with Section 1.1(a) of the Freedom of information Act 2000, the information you seek is not held by Amgueddfa Cymru – National Museum Wales.
