Before your visit... Read the following information about St Teilo's church and answer the questions.





About St Teilo's Church

- St Teilo's church is from Llandeilo Tal-y-bont, near Swansea in Wales.
- It is over 800 years old.



St Teilo's Church, Llandeilo Tal-y-bont, in situ in 1984

 In 1980, the church looked like this. The building is very old. The roof was missing, because a thief took the tiles. Nobody looked after the church and it was falling down.

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About St Teilo's Church

- St Fagans Museum wanted to save the church. In 1984, staff from the Museum started to move the church from Llandeilo to St Fagans. This takes a long time.
- Students from The University of Wales study the paintings on the walls of the church.
- Artists paint new pictures. Carpenters use wood to make a new roof. They decorate the church to show how it looks in the year 1530.
- In 2007 the church opens in St Fagan's. People from all over the world come and visit the church.







St Fagan's National Museum of History

This worksheet is for ESOL Entry 1 level (beginner) learners. They are split into three sections.

- Section one is an introduction to the church and should be completed prior to a visit to the museum.
- Section two contains activities which can be completed during a visit.
- Section three comprises of feedback activities to be completed after the visit.

Section one | Before your visit

Warmer: Look at the picture of the church and elicit learners' knowledge of St Fagan's Museum and the church.









Reading and Comprehension |

Learners work in pairs and read through the text, taking turns to read a paragraph.

Nominate learners to read text to the class. Focus on the pronunciation of the words highlighted in red.

Answer the three questions individually or as a group and check answers.

True or false |

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Several true or false statements to be read and answered.

Vocabulary | Word match

Learners work individually to match the words to the pictures. Check in pairs and feedback to class.

Section two | On your visit

Explain to the learners that there are many beautiful paintings in St Teilo's church. These paintings show how the church would have looked in 1530. Many people at this time could not read or write so the paintings were used to teach people about the Christian faith.







Looking and discussing | Task 1

One of the paintings they will be able to see, shows the Bible story of Noah's Ark.

Learners work in pairs to identify the picture and if they are familiar with the story they can explain it to their partner.

Identifying colours | Task 2

Four colours are given. As a class ask learners to identify the different colours in the picture.

Identifying colours | Task 3

Read the question and then have learners work individually to identify the colours and feedback to class.

Vocabulary | Word match | Task 4

Learners work individually. Look at the images and chose which word matches the image.

Looking | Finding people | Task 5

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Individually or as a class, find the people pictured.







Looking | Match the image | Task 6

Once learners have identified the people encourage them to speak with museum staff to identify the people by name.

Finding pictures and objects | Task 7

Individually or as a class try to find the objects pictured within the building. Encourage them to speak with museum staff to help. Each object or set of objects has accompanying questions.

Taking pictures |

Encourage learners to take pictures to share with the class.

Section three | after your visit

Warmer: After the visit, ask the learners to share any interesting information they found out about the church. Ask them which painting was their favourite and encourage the students to share any photos from the visit.

Reading | Task 1

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Look at the picture and then individually read through the description.







Present continuous verbs | Task 2

Nominate learners to read through the description of the painting. If necessary focus on the use of the present continuous to describe the picture.

Learners work in pairs to find and underline all the present continuous verbs.

Discuss | Task 3

In pairs encourage learners to discuss a picture from the church.

Writing | Task 4

Using the photos taken during the visit, learners write a description of their favourite painting.









Answers | Section one

What is this buiding? This is St Teilo's church in St Fagans Museum.

How old is it? St Teilo's was probably built in the late 12th -13th century. So it is over 800 years old.

Who visits the building today? The building is open to the public in St Fagans, so people from all over the world visit the building. Services are still held in the church and are attended by people from Llandeilo Tal-y-bont, where the church was originally situated.

In these pictures you can see a crown of thorns, three dice, and a hammer. These are all items from the story of the crucifixion of Jesus. The pictures are small. They make up part of the window. The window can be seen behind the altar.

This old chest was used to keep the priest's vestments, which are the special clothes worn by priests during ceremonies.

This picture shows Jesus surrounded by different tools. The tools appear to be hurting Jesus. This picture was used to show people that they must not work on a Sunday.
