CYFARWYDDIADAU



- 1 Gwnewch yn siŵr bod yr holl bethau uchod o'ch blaen.
- 2 Cymysgwch y paent glas a gwyn i greu glas golau. Bydd angen mwy o baent glas na gwyn, ond os yw'r glas yn rhy dywyll, ychwanegwch ragor o wyn.
- 3 Defnyddiwch y paent glas a'r un brwsh i baentio'r awyr (rhif 1).

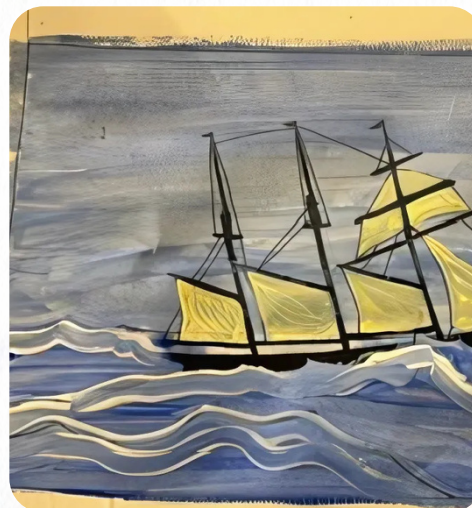
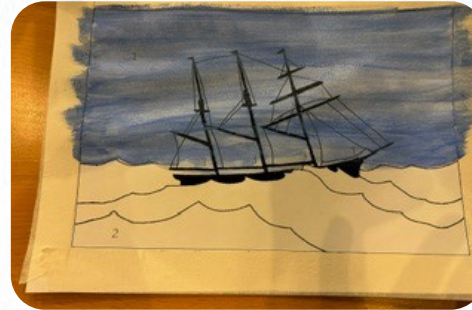
- 1 Make sure you have everything you need in front of you.
- 2 Mix the blue and white paint to make a light blue. You will need to use more blue than white, but if the blue is too dark add more white to lighten it.
- 3 Using the blue paint and the same brush, paint the sky (labelled 1).



CYFARWYDDIADAU



- 4 Defnyddiwch yr un brwsh i greu paent glas tywyllwch a phaentio'r môr (rhif 2).
- 5 Nawr mae'n amser paentio'r hwyliau (rhif 3) – defnyddiwch gymysgedd o baent gwyn ac ychydig o baent melyn.
- 6 Ychwanegwch y tonnau. Golchwch y brwsh, yna'i roi yn y paent gwyn. Paentiwch dros linellau du'r tonnau.
- 7 Nawr mae'n amser ysgwyd y llun i'w sychu!

INSTRUCTIONS



- 4 Using the same brush make a darker blue and paint the sea (labelled 2).
- 5 Time to paint the sails. Use white mixed with a little yellow (labelled 3).
- 6 Add the waves. Wash the brush in the water and dip into the white paint. Paint the white over the black wave lines.
- 7 Now it's time to shake the painting dry!
